Program Components and Level Explanations

Categories

Cubs 8 years and younger, Springs 10 years and younger and Basic Novice A receive marks for:

- Skating Skills
- Performance / Execution

The factor of the program components is **2.5**.

Levels explanations: In all elements that are subject to levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel

Basic Novice B receives marks for:

- Skating skills
- Performance / Execution
- Interpretation

The factor of the program components is **1.7** for girls and **2.0** for boys

Levels explanations: In all elements that are subject to levels, features up to **Level 3** will be counted.

Advanced Novice receives marks for:

- Skating skills
- Transitions
- Performance / Execution
- Interpretation

The factors for the Program Components is Short Program: **0.8** for girls and **1.0** for boys. Free Skating: **1.6** for girls and **2.0** for boys

Levels explanations: In all elements that are subject to Levels, features up to **Level 3** will be counted.

Junior and Senior receive marks according to ISU Rules:

- Skating skills
- Transitions
- Performance / Execution
- Choreography
- Interpretation

The factors for the Program Components is Short Program: **0.8** for ladies and girls and **1.0** for men. Free Skating: **1.6** for girls and **2.0** for boys

Levels explanations: In all elements that are subject to Levels, features up to **Level 4** will be counted.
