The Icelandic Skating Association would like to invite you to participate in the Interclub Figure Skating Competition at the Reykjavik International Games 2019 (RIG). Reykjavík International Games is a multisport event which is hosted by Reykjavík city over a two-week period. Further information about the multisport events can be found at www.rig.is.

This will be the 12th year figure skating is part of the Reykjavík International Games, and the 6th year on the list of ISU competitions. It is with great pleasure we welcome figure skaters from figure skating clubs and ISU Member Federations to participate in this interclub figure skating competition for young and upcoming skaters. The competition will take place immediately preceding our ISU competition for Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice.

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

Reykjavík International Games 2019 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Reykjavík International Games 2019** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

Entries can be done by respective ISU Member Federations or by clubs.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

PLACE Main arena (MR): Laugardalur Ice Arena, Múlavegi 1, Reykjavík (an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated)

2.1 COMPETING CATEGORIES

Competition rules for all categories will be according to the Icelandic Skating Association's National Competition Rules (see in Appendix).

Competition categories are the following:

Chicks	Not older than 8 on July 1. 2018	FS
Cubs	Not older than 10 on July 1. 2018	FS
Intermediate Ladies	Not younger than 15 on July 1. 2018	FS
Basic Novice	Has not reached the age of 13 on July 1. 2018	FS
Intermediate Novice	Has not reached the age of 15 on July 1. 2018	FS





3. ENTRIES

The Entry Forms are available on the competition's website www.iceskate.is/rig2019. Please e-mail Entry Forms to events@iceskate.is. GDPR Policy (form RIG08) must be signed by each competitor and sent with entries for an entry to be valid.

3.1 Entries of competitors

The entries by name should reach the organizer no later than <u>Friday, November 30th 2018</u>. The official entry form, **RIG08**, for the RIG Interclub competition must be used.

Confirmation of the skaters accepted to the competition will be published on the website not later than **December 10**th, **2018.**

3.2 Entry fee

The entry fee for the interclub competition is 80 € per participant.

The entry fee must be paid by **Friday, November 30**th **2018** to the following bank account – we kindly ask members/clubs to make **one payment transaction for all their skaters** and mark it with the text "**RIG2019**".

In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category by another skater from the same member until **January 20th 2019.** Participating members are asked to immediately inform of any changes in their entries by email to <u>events@iceskate.is</u>.

Entry fees are not refunded in case of withdrawal after **November 30**th **2018.** Entry fee will be refunded if the skater is not accepted (if there will be a limitation of the numbers of entries).

4. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will not cover the expenses of the teams. Travel expenses, meals and accommodation will be covered by the participants.

5. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2; all Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality in CD or any other approved format. The medium with the music files will be kept until the end of the competition. Competitors must provide a back-up drive for each program.





The organizer asks to receive all competition music in MP3 format via **events@iceskate.is** no later than **January 18**th **2019**.

A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program must be listed for each Competitor on the official **Music Selection Form RIG08**.

All competitors shall furnish extra copy of competition music of excellent quality on either CD or any other electronic means to have available at the rink during their event (playback from phones is not accepted), in accordance with ISU Rule 343, paragraph 2. Each program (short/free) must be recorded on one track respectively on a separate disc. Discs must show the competition event, competitors name, nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal.

The Program Component Sheet RIG05 must be sent together with the music to events@iceskate.is no later than <u>January 18th 2019</u>. The Program Component Sheet must be filled in precisely by each skater in English using the Terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

6. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

The international airport. Keflavik Airport (KEF), is located with a distance of 40 km from the capital. Travel from the airport to Reykjavík with Fly-bus takes approx. 50 min.

The competitors, coaches and additional team officials are responsible for their own arrangements concerning ground transportation to and from the airport.

Buses are available from Keflavík airport and stop at all main hotels. Further information about the bus service can be found at www.kefairport.is/english/to-andfrom-the-airport/buses/ and www.re.is/flybus/.

All Competitors, Team Leaders, Team Officials and Coaches taking part in the competition are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but no later than January 4th 2019, the name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and times of arrival at Keflavík International Airport or any other information concerning transportation and arrivals. The travel form RIG04 should be used. All Officials will have arranged transport from Keflavík Airport.

7. OFFICIAL HOTEL

The Organizer will make the room arrangements for invited officials only.

All competitors, coaches and team leaders as well as team officials, medical staff and chaperones are asked to take care of their accommodation and bear their own expenses.

8. ACCREDITATION

The Accreditation is planned at the ice rink / Laugardalur Ice Arena upon arrival Thursday, January 31st from 18.00-22:00 and on Friday, February 1st from 08:00.

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and one Team Leader per participating team, one Coach per competitor, two medical persons and one Team Official of ISU Members. Accreditation will only be granted to persons in those various functions if officially entered and named through their ISU Member.

Chaperons will not receive accreditation.





9. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

In categories Chicks and Cubs the total score will not be announced at competition. Furthermore the best placed competitors will not be announced but every competitor will receive a participation diploma.

In categories Intermediate Ladies, Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice the three best placed competitors in each event will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists.

10. PROTOCOL / LIST OF RESULTS

11. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditions.
