Intermediate Ladies/Men (15 years and older) receive marks for:

- Skating Skills
- Transitions
- Performance
- Composition
- Interpretation of the music

The factor of the program components is **1.3. Levels explanations:** In all elements that are subject to levels, only features up to **Level 4** will be counted.

No half time bonus will be given.
