



RE: Video entries for TES to be considered for JGP 2021

Considering the limited number of competitions in the 2020-2021 season and different access to ice time between skaters in the season the Icelandic Skating Association with ÍSS's Elite committee have decided to give skaters equal opportunity to be considered for the Junior Grand Prix 2021.

All skaters who are eligible to compete as Juniors for the 2021-2022 season and want to be considered as an ÍSS representative at JGP 2021 must send in a video of both their short and free programs.

After the deadline to submit videos a panel of judges and technical specialists/controllers will review the videos. The TES obtained will only be valid for the selection of representatives for JGP 2021.

Entries of skaters

- Skaters eligible as Juniors for the 2021-2022 season can be entered
- Only skaters who submit videos will be considered as representatives at JGP 2021
- PPC for both programs must be sent in with entries

Deadline to enter skaters and submit videos

Entries are open from April 10th 2021. Once skaters are entered a link will be sent where the videos can be uploaded.

Last day to submit videos is on **May 1st 2021**.

Entries and/or videos submitted after that date will not be considered.

Video submissions

- Only one video may be submitted of each program
- Skaters must be entered through the published link before videos are submitted
- Videos may be recorded at any time between April 10th and May 1st 2021
Still only 72 hours may pass between the recording of each program.
EG: If one program is recorded in the morning of April 15th the other program shall be recorded no later than the morning of April 18th.
- Skaters submit a day and time of the recording by holding a phone in front of the camera.

Video requirements

- The camera must be elevated and if possible situated where the Technical-/judges panel are positioned during competitions

- If recording with a **mobile phone** only «landscape» orientation is accepted. The phone must be on «airplane mode» during the recording.
- The camera must be in one place during the recording
- Use the camera «zoom» feature when (if) they move to the other side of the rink.
- Make sure that the music is clear on the recording
- Lighting on the ice-surface shall be at competition level
- Only .mp4 files are accepted
- Videos must be named with the skaters full name and the program segment applicable
EG: SP_Jóna Jónsdóttir / FS_Jóna Jónsdóttir

How to film

If using a phone or tablet you need to film in «landscape» mode. Follow these instructions:

1. Go to Settings – Camera – Record Video for iPhones or open you camera application for Android, choose “Camera settings” and select “Rear Video Size” resolution 1080 at 60 fps.
2. Choose 1080p at 60p
3. Switch to Airplane Mode
4. Make sure there is enough space available on your phone to record. Recommend at least 2GB of available space.
5. Clean your camera lens
